DON'T MISS THAT BIG TROPHY THIS SEASON

- Starts May 6th through August 16th
- No league from July 1st – July 5th for the 4th of July weekend
- Shooters have from Wednesday 4PM to sundown on Sunday.
 - A new course is set by a different team every week on Tuesday night.
 - Unfortunately due to a new course every week we cannot shoot ahead or make up weeks of shooting. The course must be shot that week.
 - Shooter can miss weeks without greatly affecting individual & team score
- Teams consist of 4 archers (Partial teams are available to complete full teams, see contact info)
- Archer classes:
 - Hunter I: Traditional (no sights or release aid)
 - Hunter II: Fixed Pin (fixed pin or movable pin sights, with release aid)
 - Crossbow
 - Women
 - Juniors: Ages 12-16
 - Cub/cadets: ages up through 11
- Archers shoot a handicap through the duration of the league to keep it fun & enjoyable for everyone.
- Every week teams shoot against another team.
- Scoring, handicap & information will be posted on the info board west of the north shed.
- End of the season Shoot Offs/Banquet: August 19th
 - Come enjoy a night of shooting, with large prize raffle, awards, team tournaments (4-man team & individual), door prizes & food
- Fees – league participants must be club members
 - \$50.00 sponsorship fee per team
 - \$50.00 per shooter (Hunter 1/Hunter 2/Crossbow/Women/Juniors)
 - \$25.00 for Cubs/Cadets

** All fees & memberships must be paid by 5/17 **
- Club Household Membership - \$75.00: Membership includes access to all that the club has to offer: Trap, 5 Stand, 100 yd Rifle Range & 25ft Pistol Range. Work 4 hours & pay 50% next years membership.

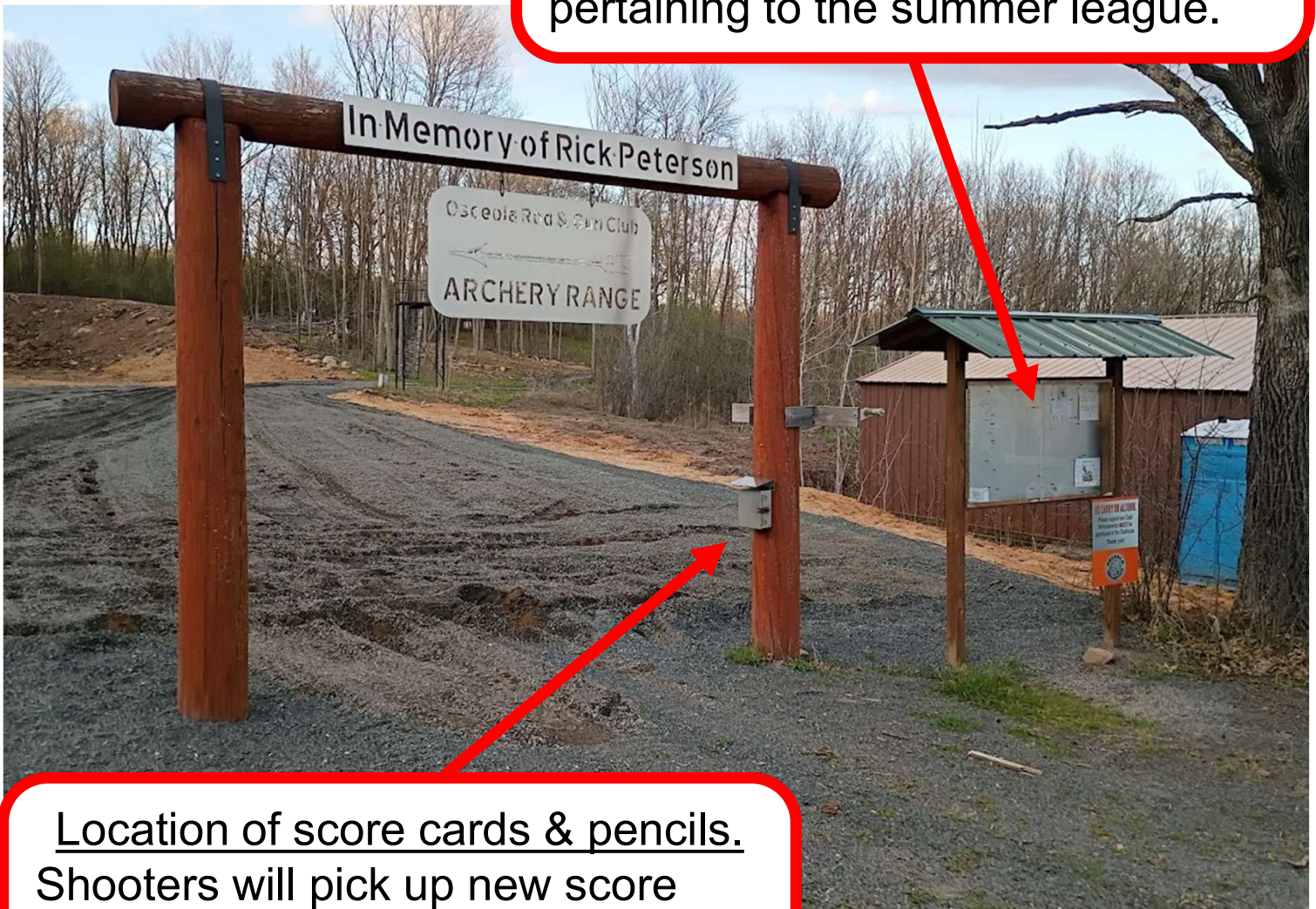

All league information will be posted here. Scores, dates, all info pertaining to the summer league.

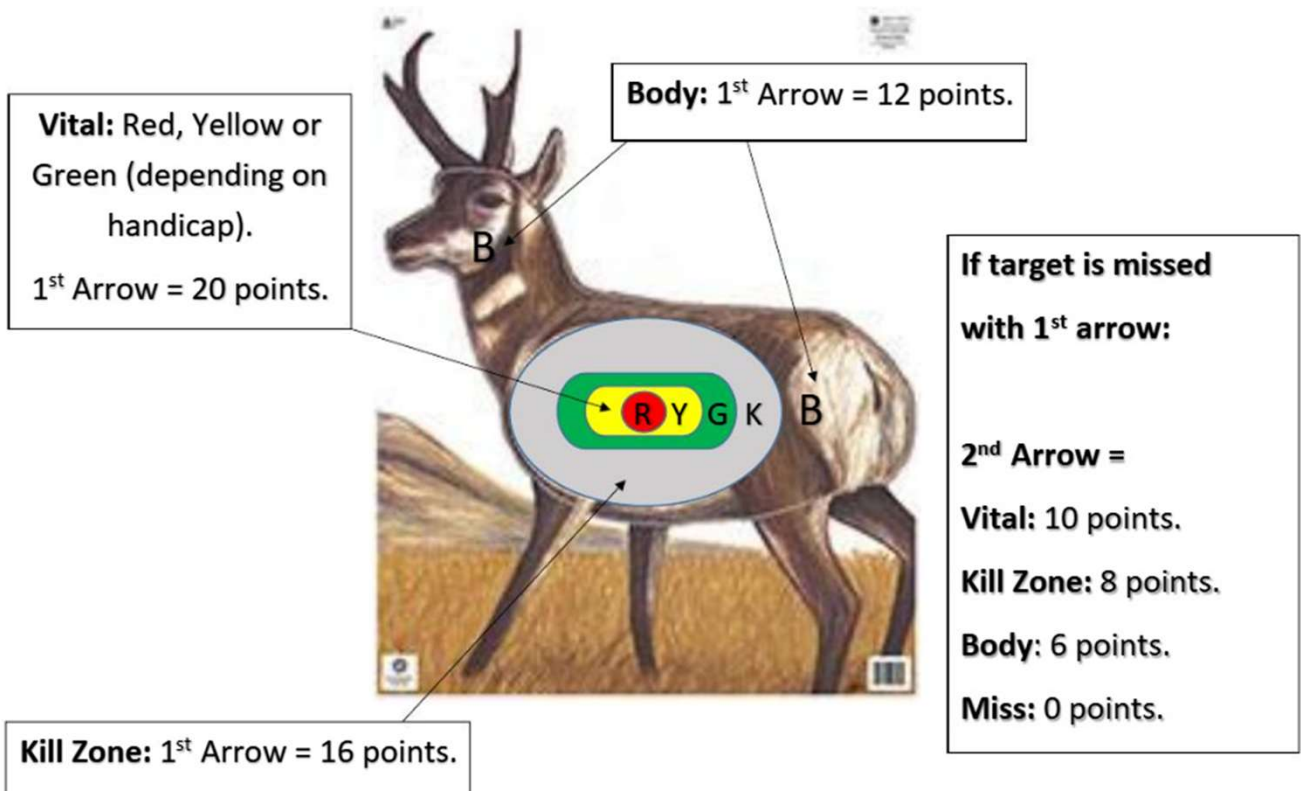


Location of score cards & pencils.
Shooters will pick up new score card on left & drop completed score cards on the right.



Scoring:

- The shooter gets one shot. Unless the first shot results in a miss.
- Scoring Rings:
 - Handicap is based on scoring ring. All shooters will shoot a yellow handicap the first week.
 - Red Handicap:
 - Shot in:
 - Red outline = 20
 - Yellow/Green/Kill = 16
 - Body = 12
 - Yellow Handicap:
 - Shot in:
 - Red/Yellow Outline = 20
 - Green/Kill = 16
 - Body - 12
 - Green Handicap:
 - Shot in:
 - Red/Yellow/Green = 20
 - Kill = 16
 - Body = 12
 - Touching the line goes to higher scoring ring.

- Orange: Cub/Cadet



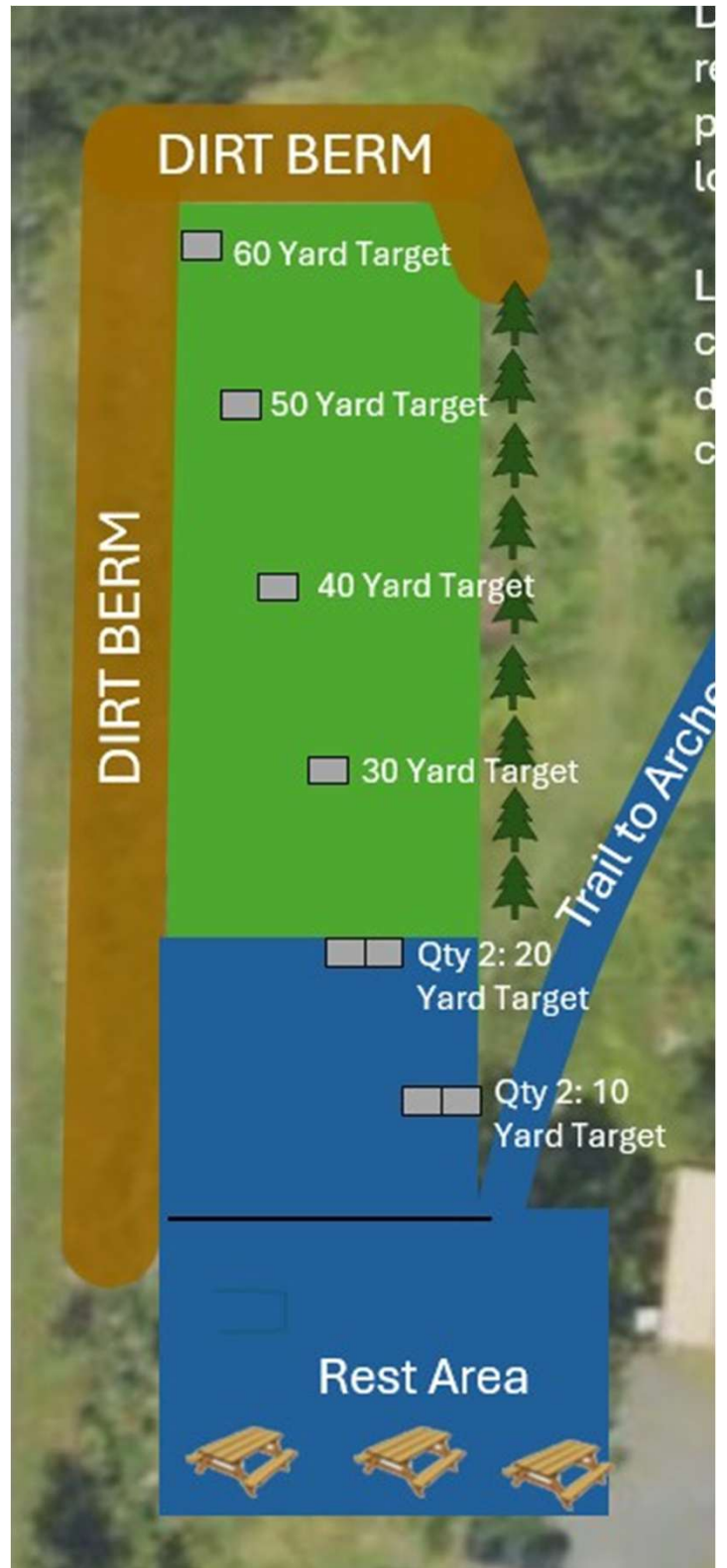
Course Setting:

- There will be a rooster for a date to set the course posted on the information board.
- Please sign your team up for a week to set the course.
 - The week you sign your team up for is the target your team will be in charge of maintaining. There are mowers and weed whackers in the shed for use. When the club is open.
- When it is your week to set the course. Your team will come Tuesday night and ask the bartender for the key for the north shed.
- There will be instructions in the shed to set the course.



INFO to Remember:

- Shooters have from Wednesday evening through Sunday dark to shoot their score round for the wk.
- Wednesday evening the Club is open from 5 to 10 pm. This is considered “Archery Night”.
 - The rifle & pistol ranges are shut down this night for archery.
 - Come in after shooting & enjoy a beverage, pizza and/or burger. Enjoy the comradery of fellow archers.
 - Trap ranges will be open bring your shotgun and shoot some rounds.
 - 5 stand range will be open starting in June, bring your shotgun & practice up for the next upland season.
- We will be looking for volunteers to pack bunkers (date TBD) & help set up & tear down for the 3d shoot May 30th.
- The team captains are responsible for forwarding information to their team members via text or email.
- Bare with us as the course is still a work in progress. As grant money is awarded and used the course will continue to grow. The side picture is a rough idea of the end result of the practice range.



Dates to Remember:

- May 6th – 1st Wk of league starts
- May 10th – 1st Wk score has to be shot & turned in
- May 13th – 2nd Wk of league starts
- May 17th – 2nd Wk score has to be shot & turned in
- May 17th : all fees and memberships must be purchased by this day by all team members.
- May 30th : 3D Shoot
- Wk 3 through Wk 14 follow. Wednesday through Sunday
- No league July 1st through July 5th
- Last Wk of league – August 12th through August 16th
- August : 19th : Shoot Off & Banquet
 - Shooting starts @ 4 PM.
 - Members must shoot that evening for their score round to count.
 - Shooters must be present for door prizes and raffles.
- August 8th : The Annual Shooting Triathlon
